



6 — Month Bible Reading Plan

Do you find the Old Testament, with its books of law back-to-back and books of prophecy back-to-back, tiring to read straight through? Me too. Do you dislike Bible reading plans that have you hopping all over the Bible each day, in an effort to read it chronologically? Yeah, those aren't my favourite either.

Do you want an easy plan that's shorter than a year, but doesn't require more than an average of six chapters a day? What about a plan that helps you discover the relationship between the Old Testament imagery/prophecies of Jesus and the Jesus we know from the New Testament? And would you like a plan that offers you a bite full of comfort or wisdom as you feed on the Word of God each day?

Great! Then this is the Bible reading plan for you...

The Plan:

Most days, you'll read an average of six chapters – five chapters from either the Old or New Testament, plus one chapter from either the Psalms or Proverbs. About one quarter of the way through the Old Testament, you'll flip forward and read one gospel from the New Testament. Then, half way through the Old Testament, you'll read another gospel; and, again, at the three-quarter mark. This will allow you to break up the lengthy Old Testament with easier-to-read books, but I also believe it will help you understand the parallels between Old Testament Laws and Jesus' sacrifice and resurrection, and you'll more easily notice how each of the Old Testament prophecies were fulfilled in Jesus.

Ready to begin?

(HINT: If I fall behind on my chapters during the work week, I like to catch up by listening to a free audio bible version on www.BibleGateway.com while cleaning or when I head to bed.)
